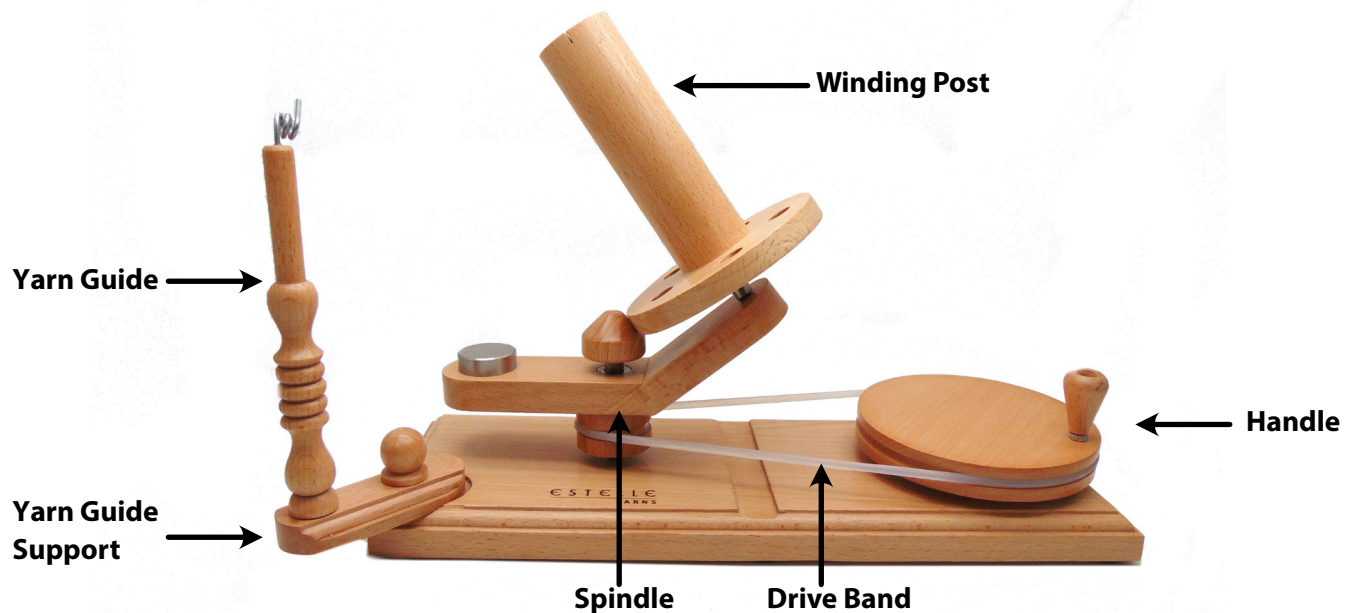




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Jumbo Beech Yarn Winder

C – Spindle Support

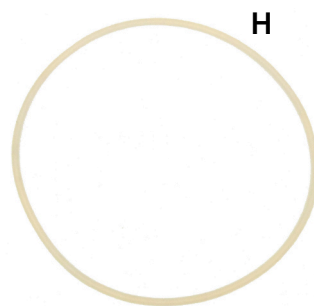
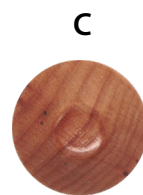
D – Clamp

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

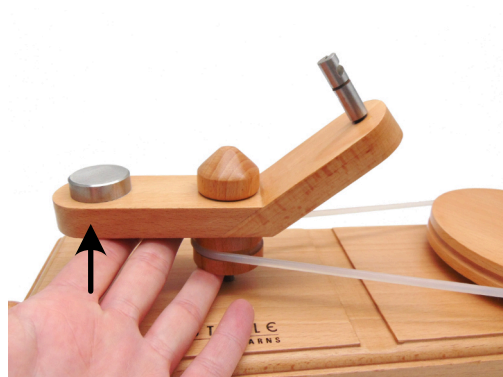
Step 1: Unpack winder from box, and remove all protective wrapping.



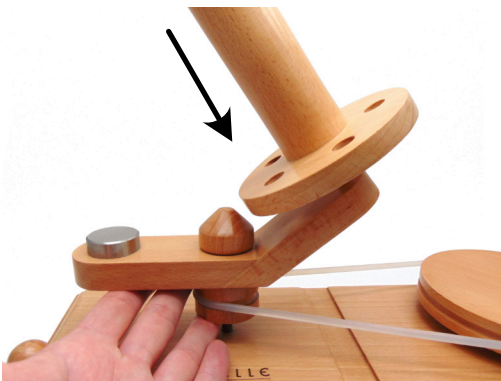
Step 2: Place a few drops of oil on the metal post that the spindle sits on.



Step 3: Lift the spindle as high up as it will go on the post.



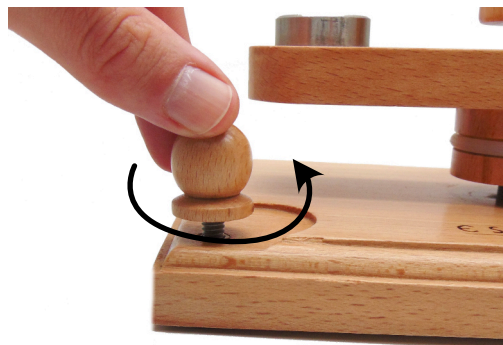
Step 4: Place the winding post onto the spindle, while keeping the spindle raised.



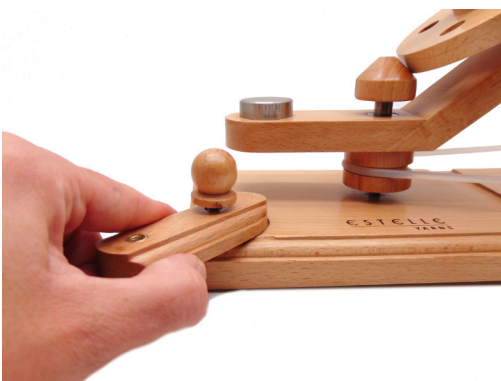
Step 5: Let go of the spindle, so that the winding post rests on the spindle support as shown below.



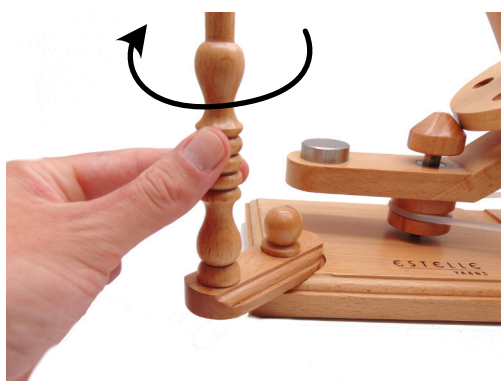
Step 6: Remove the guide support screw by turning it to the left.



Step 7: Place the yarn guide support into the groove on the base, then insert the guide support screw and turn it to the right to tighten it.



Step 8: Install the yarn guide into the yarn guide support, and turn it to the right to tighten it.



Step 9: Clamp the winder to a table, placing it a minimum of 12" (30cm) away from the swift. The winder can be clamped with the handle to the right as shown, or to the left for left-handed use.
